Be sure to save your application on your computer so you will have a copy.


Please read the application materials thoroughly. Attached you will find:

2012 Scholarship Program

Eligibility

Must be a current regular or associate member of Rocky Mountain Farmers Union.

- Farmers Union and Community Activities, 40 percent
- Academic Record, 25 percent
- Written Essay, 25 percent
- Letters of Recommendation, 10 percent

- Completed application form.
- Current high school or college transcripts.
- ACT or SAT scores.
- Two letters of recommendation on official letterhead.
- Written essay, 2-3 pages in length, size 12 font, on:
 - Knowledge of Farmers Union and its affiliates;
 - Financial need for scholarship; and
 - Personal leadership abilities, achievements and career goals.
- Photo to be used in the *Union Farmer* and local newspapers.
